- No Cheating (results in disqualification). *
- If a team has less than 6 players because of disqualified player(s) then the team will also be disqualified
- Once a team is registered the players must be present with the team for each game. No team can get another player once they are registered.
- Each team must have 6 players on the mat to begin the game.
- Once a team has 6 players on the mat, a timer of **10 minutes** will begin. If the opposing team does not have 6 players on the mat by the end of the timer, they will forfeit the game resulting in the other team advancing.
- If the shooter points while a player(s) is not ready, then the team will hide again and the shooter must give up 1 stick.
- 2 judges must be present to begin the game
- No arguing, swearing or yelling at other players, judges or staff.
- **No sunglasses, gloves or hoods** (note: This is a rule elders had but was never explained to me why but I respect their teachings and will continue to honor that tradition whether players agree with it or not. Thank you for your understanding.)
